The mission and purpose of the Defense Contractor Complex is to provide the aviation and aerospace industry with a secure center to build-up, test and complete technological based activities in Southwest Arizona. Our airport offers a combined package of first-class accommodations and business support, right next door to the Marine Corps Air Station Yuma and U.S. Army Yuma Proving Ground. The DCC is ideally suited for aircraft maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) operations and a variety of aviation-related industrial and commercial development opportunities.




The Defense Contractor Complex is located in the southwest portion of Yuma International Airport. With clean desert air, low humidity, minimal rain fall (approximately 3" annually), an average of 350 sunny days every year, four (4) runways with lengths ranging from 13,300' to 5,710', these key factors provide up to near perfect testing and contractor support conditions!



Yuma International Airport has the added benefit of being an Airport Authority. As an independent public agency, the Airport Authority has the ability to finalize the lease/construction process in a fraction of the time in comparison to other competitive sites.

The benefits of using the DCC include tailored tenant agreements according to individual needs, maintenance hangars, ample ramp parking, specialized aviation support, office space, high speed broadband, security, CCTV and secure parking, site access 24 hours a day all year round, marketing support, tenant networking opportunities and workshops, city center location just five minutes away, and home-grown talent who offer an excellent range of defense-based expertise including engineering, servicing, research & development.
